The exhibition, which takes place in autumn 2023 at the Kunsthalle Palazzo, is entitled Coniunctio. This is a term borrowed from the Latin language, which can mean connection, context, conviviality, friendship or kinship. This term also stands for the grammatical connective word, the conjunction, which is used to connect words, parts of sentences or phrases. As this title suggests, the exhibition will revolve around connections. The four invited artists each dealt with this topic in their own way in their works. Andrea Wolfensberger's latest work, for example, is about networks and braids created from mycelia, the thread-like cells of a fungus. Artist Noemi Pfister, on the other hand, is always interested in connections and relationships in her painting, drawing on works from art history or elements from popular culture and combining them to create enigmatic images. Lorenza Diaz has repeatedly created large-scale murals that established a connection between walls, ceilings, and floors, or even between different rooms, setting static architecture in motion. For this exhibition, she dedicates herself to the superimposition of exterior and interior and has moved a panoramic view of nature in a painterly way into the exhibition context. And the Russian artist Natalia Peredvigina, stranded in Switzerland, undertakes small interventions made of textiles, which connect the works of the three other artists and the premises of the Kunsthalle Palazzo like visual conjunctions. The exhibition sees itself as a plea for togetherness instead of opposition and is conceived as an open experimental arrangement to sensitize our senses to connections. The exhibition was curated by Michael Babics and Olivia Jenni.
